September 27, 1976 - August 10, 2014

Aron Tobias Bendix passed away on Sunday, Aug. 10, 2014 in Grass Valley, Calif. He was 37.

Family and friends are invited to a visitation and funeral service for Aron at 1 p.m. on Thurs., Aug. 21 starting at the Chapel of the Angels Mortuary 250 Race Street, Grass Valley, CA.

Aron was born in Grass Valley on Sept. 27, 1976 to his mother Delores and his father Garry. He was a beloved son, brother, grandson, nephew, cousin, uncle and friend.

Aron's family moved around a lot before finally settling down in Grass Valley. He was well liked by his teachers and friends, especially the girls! Many of the friendships that were established in elementary school held strong and still remain today. To his family and friends, Aron was a loyal, trustworthy, and kind addition to their lives. All in all, Aron was an adventurous, creative, funny, and loving person who was loved unconditionally by his family and friends and who will be dearly missed but never forgotten. We will always remember him with that classic grin on his face.

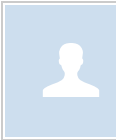

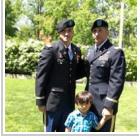
