Bruce Norman Pusheck died Aug. 19, 2016 at his home in Lake Wildwood, Penn Valley, CA. He was 82.

Bruce was born in Chicago, IL on April 30, 1934 to Vernon Charles Pusheck and Mary Etta Layton (Morris) Pusheck.
