December 1, 1949 - February 27, 2017

Carolyn Mae Longhenry Cochrun from Penn Valley, California, formerly from Jackson, Ohio, went to be with the Lord on Monday the 27th of February at her home, after a second valiant battle with breast cancer.

Born in 1949 in Columbus, Ohio, Carolyn lived in Powell, Ohio and graduated from Olentangy High School in 1967.

After moving to Jackson, Ohio, Carolyn began her career as a Social Worker in Children's Services of the Jackson County Welfare Department. She retired as a Social Worker from the Athens County Welfare Department. In 2011, she moved to California to be with her son and family.

She loved playing cards with family and friends, especially euchre, and she enjoyed crocheting. She was an avid Buckeye and Packers fan. She attended several churches throughout Jackson County. She was very devoted to Jesus and spent time reading her Bible and praying for others around the world.

She was preceded in death by father, Louis (Bud) Longhenry, and brother, Jim Longhenry.
