



## CHARLENE TAYLOR

June 9, 1931 - April 8, 2019

Charlene Taylor passed away at Springhill Manor on April 8, 2019. She was 87.

She was born in Denver, CO in 1931 to Charles Eggert and Madeline Kilhofer Eggert. The family moved to Oakland, CA in the 1940's, where she graduated from Oakland High in 1949. She met future husband Jim Taylor in 1952, and they were married in April, 1954.
