July 7, 1923 - May 20, 2015

Dot Alverson passed away peacefully on May 20, 2015 in Grass Valley, after a long and well-lived life. She was 92.

Born Dot E. Plaster in St. Croix Falls Wisconsin, April 7, 1923, she graduated from St. Croix Falls High School, was trained as a nurse's aide and worked at the hospital in St. Croix Falls.

On Aug. 4, 1945, she married First Lt. Henry A. Alverson, U.S. Army, and spent the next 25 years as a military wife living in many places across the United States and in Okinawa, Japan.

Henry's last assignment was at Hamilton Air Force Base in Marin County, where they lived until they moved to Grass Valley in 1979.

She made lifelong friends wherever she went and will be sorely missed by all who knew and loved her.

She was adventurous, had a great sense of humor and was loving and kind. She was a longtime member of the Grass Valley United Methodist Church, belonged to two hiking clubs, one in Arizona and one in Grass Valley.

She hiked the Grand Canyon, sailed through the Panama Canal and visited

England.
