November 2, 1934 - August 24, 2015

Edwin (Darrell) Stone passed away Aug. 24, 2015 at the age of 80, after a massive heart attack at Mercy General in Sacramento.

He had a very large circle of friends and family, ranging from elementary and

high school friends to individuals he met in his adult life.

He truly cherished them all. He was a gregarious man, quick to laugh heartily and really enjoyed life to the fullest. Darrell lived life on his own terms and was true to himself.

After retirement, he and his wife moved to Grass Valley in 1995. He knew he had arrived in paradise and wanted to be in no other place.

He is survived by Natalie, his loving wife of 38 years and son Robin and daughter-in-law Melanie.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Wilma Ruth and Dale, and his daughter Julie Stone.
