He and his first wife, mother of his daughters, Jan Jones, moved to Redwood City, CA in 1964, where Brian later received his Ph.D. in Psychology at Stanford University. He spent the rest of his life living his passion for helping others with that profession in various roles-- a counselor and mentor until his final days. Brian interwove his love of Jesus Christ into every aspect of his life and family, and always laid that as the foundation of all work. This included forming and running the Coalition of Christian Counseling Services with second wife, Linda Phillips-Jones. The final love of his life, Cherie Stevens-Jones, has helped continue to manage this Coalition for the past 7 years of their marriage. Brian left this earth in the arms of his biggest love, Cherie, who he deemed "a country woman who honors and adores 98% of me with a kindness, gentleness and passion that I never thought possible from anyone, and who treasures and radiates the love of Jesus Christ . . .
