Mark Weyman of Chicago Park died at his home on Jan. 26, 2015.

Mark was born April 8, 1947, in Berkeley, Calif., to Walter and Ruth Weyman. He lived all his life in Northern California, apart from time spent commercial fishing in Alaska and the East Coast, and responding to the call of adventure at every opportunity.

He earned a bachelor's degree in journalism from Humboldt State University.

Mark married Gail Damskey in 1973. They moved to Nevada City in 1977, where their daughter Alyse was born that year. They divorced in 1988. Mark married Jeanie Rekers in 1989.

Mark was deeply involved in the community, especially the preservation of open spaces, which along with boating and his small farm, were his passions.

Mark worked at Coldwell Banker Grass Roots Realty, earning Agent of the Year recognition. He was a charter member of the Nevada County Association of Realtors Master's Club and a member of the Nevada County Land Trust.

Mark is survived by his wife, Jeanie Weyman; daughter Alyse Marika Weyman; stepdaughter Korie Rekers; sisters, Paula Renate Lalish and Toni

Weyman Droscher and their husbands; as well as nieces, nephews, cousins and numerous beloved pets.

Mark was preceded in death by his parents.

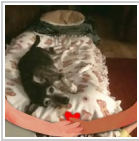
