One being blue and one pink, we wore these all summer. We talked about our playhouses. Making hula skirts out of brown grass feed sacks. We would pull out all of the cross strings, only leaving enough for a waistband then we would pin them with a diaper pin. We would get in the front yard and do the hula when cars would go by. Since we lived on a country gravel road our preformances were far and inbetween. As kids we went for walks in the woods to get persimmons, and mama always telling us to watch out for bulls, since a neighbor guy had been killed by them. And sure enough we would see a bull in the field close to the persimmon tree. We never did know if that was the same bull. I don't think we were suppose to know. We always had to watch out for sink holes and wells in the woods,snakes in the chicken nest and being chased by the white goose. We talked about planting the garden on one occasion. Our dad showed us how far apart to plant the bean seeds. So our younger sister Eve found her a little stick and broke it to the proper length she needed, so she could place each seed exactly the same distance apart. We would look at her and then each other laughing while we were picking up speed going down our rolls. Our dad told us we needed to tend to our own business, with a smile on his face. That was the prettiest roll of beans we had ever seen! Mama taught us how to can lots of work but so much fun. I could just go on and on there ate so many memories. My last favorite memory was the last time I was with Mary in California. We all had such a good time being together. She was so happy and said she hadn't laughed so much in a long time . we all hated to leave her. This is the memory i will hold on to forever. I cannot let go of this vision, she holds a very special place in my heart and I will cherish our many memories together. Please
