Stacie is preceded in death by father, Leo Sturm, mother Jean Sturm and sister Jana Sturm. She is survived by husband of forty-two years, Frazier Jeffery of Lake Wildwood, son Todd and daughter-in-law Virginia of Los

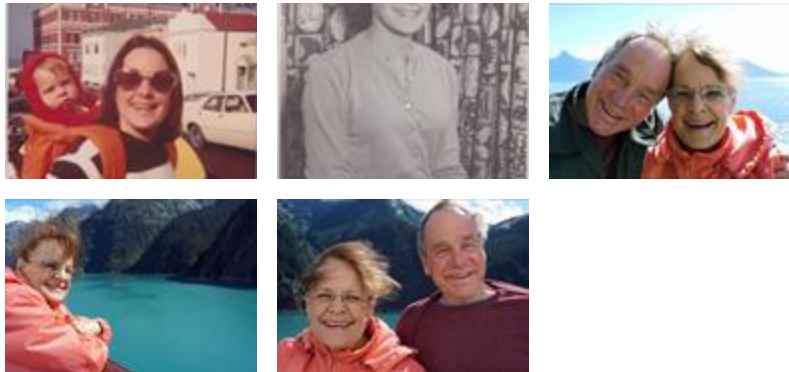
